Footnotes

TWEEBIE saved ground on the turn, swung three wide at the head of the stretch, closed between horses and was along in time. PRINCE NOIR stalked the pace, swung outside entering the stretch, gained a clear lead in midstretch, drifted out near the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. RIDDLES AND RHYMES lacked speed, swung wide turning for home and rallied. ORCHESTRATED , steadied in close quarters entering the turn, saved ground around the turn and flattened out. LORD BARRISTER bobbled at the break, swung wide entering the stretch and weakened the final furlong. MALIBU KATE passed tired horses. MY BULLET , very wide turning for home, passed tired rivals. KITTY PLEASER saved ground and was not a factor. PINS 'N NEEDLES , wide, weakened. GOLD CAPTION , steadied in traffic leaving the backstretch, was not a factor. MY BLUE EYED JAX set the pace along the rail and faltered. BEBOPING LION prompted the two wide and stopped.
