### Footnotes

SUNNY FOREST dueled in the two path inside SEARYA into the turn, dropped to the rail while continuing to duel around the turn, responded to pressure to edged clear in mid stretch then widened through the final sixteenth while kept to some hand urging. EASTER RISING chased the dueling leaders while saving ground into the turn, angled out mid turn, came four wide for the drive and finished with interest to earn the place. SO BEST, urged along towards the inside mid turn, angled out in the drive and closed between rivals. SHEA BALLETT, in mid pack off the rail, came five wide into the lane and found her best too late. QUARRY TREMOR, four wide to mid turn, dropped inside in upper stretch and continued on well inside rivals. SEARYA, three wide dueling into the turn while holding a short lead, continued a minimal advantage two wide into the lane, relinquished command in upper stretch, held well to the eighth pole then gradually gave way. MAGGIE'S CHARM swung out six wide for the drive and failed to menace. TALLY'S SONG, pinched back at the break, raced four to five wide in upper stretch and failed to menace. PIZZA LADY failed to menace. COPPER RIVER QUEST, three wide early stalking the duel, dropped back mid turn.
