Footnotes

MINESHAFT stalked the pace near the rail, eased out three wide leaving the backstretch, bid for the lead outside WESTERN PRIDE leaving the far turn and steadily pulled away through the stretch while kept to his business. WESTERN PRIDE prompted the pace outside BALTO STAR, opened a clear lead leaving the backstretch, dueled with the winner to midstretch then faded. JUDGE'S CASE lacked speed, raced two wide between horses near the three eighths pole, swung wide in midstretch and closed gamely. COLONIAL COLONY saved ground to the far turn, split foes two wide midway on the bend and flattened out. PUZZLEMENT, sluggish early, awaited room near the three eighths pole, split rivals two wide midway on the turn, angled inside in midstretch and lacked the necessary late response. SNAKE MOUNTAIN saved ground the first turn, drifted very wide leaving the far turn and weakened. AENEAS circled horses on the far turn, was carried to the six path entering the stretch and weakened. HERO'S TRIBUTE, difficult to load into the starting gate, lost ground both turns, chased the pace and gave way. BALTO STAR, sent to the front, set the pace and dropped back leaving the three eighths pole.
