**Footnotes**

MANDY'S GOLD , forwardly placed towards the inside, moved up between rivals into the lane, swung out for room leaving the furlong marker, drifted out a bit, closed determinedly when straightened under right handed pressure and wore down SUMMER COLONY in the final jumps. SUMMER COLONY broke a step slow, was urged along three wide down the backstretch while in striking position, moved closer leaving the far turn, took command nearing the furlong marker, came in a bit brushing STORMY FROLIC, edged away some a sixteenth out then just failed to last. STORMY FROLIC prompted the pace outside of DANCE THE SLEW, took over around the far turn, went clear after six furlongs, was collared by SUMMER COLONY in upper stretch, was brushed by that one leaving the eighth pole then weakened late. DANCE THE SLEW broke sharply, set the pace along the inside, took pressure down the backstretch, dueled briefly leaving the far turn then gave way in upper stretch.
