NO ADVANTAGE , four wide around the first turn, advanced three wide nearing the half mile marker, lodged a three wide bid after six furlongs, dueled to mid stretch then edged clear under strong handling. REAL MERCHANT (CHI) cleared early, set a moderate pace along the rail, was joined by the winner nearing the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the furlong marker, gave way grudgingly and saved a tie for the place. EA stumbled at the break, was rated between rivals nearing the backstretch, settled in mid pack while off the rail into the far turn, angled out four wide when advancing into the stretch and closed willingly to be on even terms with REAL MERCHANT (CHI). RICHARD'S KID , unhurried early while saving ground, angled out near the five sixteenths pole, entered the lane three wide, shifted back to the rail inside the eighth pole but lacked a solid finish. READY SET , allowed to settle while removed from the rail, shifted out four to five wide leaving the three sixteenths marker but failed to generate a threatening kick. CRIMSON COMIC bobbled at the break, raced three wide around the first turn, stalked the leader down the backstretch, made a mild challenge leaving the three eighths pole, remained a presence into the lane then faded. CAVE'S VALLEY saved ground in a forward position for five furlongs and weakened.
