Footnotes

SUMACHA'HOT was angled in early and taken to rate, advanced along the rail leaving the three eighths pole, swung out four wide into the lane, rallied under right handed pressure to take command in mid stretch then pulled away while under steady hand urging through the final sixteenth. OUT TO PLEASE was angled off the rail entering the backstretch to stalk the pace, moved to challenge after six furlongs, dueled and gained a short lead in upper stretch, was overtaken in mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. NORJAC , taken to rate, stalked the pace two wide, angled out three wide under a ride approaching the quarter pole, held well to mid stretch then faded. COURT BAND , taken to rate while off the rail, was bumped and carried out five wide by FURRARIAT mid way on the final turn, was straightened away into the lane, made some progress in mid stretch then flattened out. SIR TOGO saved ground in a good position, advanced nearing the quarter pole, eased out in upper stretch then came up empty. BELLE'S BROKER lacked speed, was lightly steadied off of FURRARIAT leaving the five sixteenths pole, swung out very wide and had some belated action. TERRIFIC TOM cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, was collared after six furlongs, dueled into the lane then weakened. THUNDER CHARM failed to menace. JOEL'S TOUCH stalked the early pace between rivals and faltered. FURRARIAT lost ground three to four wide stalking the pace, lost his action mid way on the final turn, bore out bumping with COURT BAND then was pulled up.
