SISTER BELLA (IRE) lacked speed, raced wide into the far turn and narrowly prevailed in an extended drive. DREAMS AND WISHES set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. BAIL MONEY raced between horses on the far turn, swung outside in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. AMOURETTE stalked the pace three wide and failed to threaten. GARDEN SPOT raced in a forward position two wide and weakened. ASHLEY'S COY lacked speed and was no factor. MEANS OF GRACE raced wide and weakened. LITLEDRUMMERGIRL saved ground and gave way.
