Footnotes

AZIREPRICE was unhurried early while five wide, commenced a five wide rally leaving the far turn, surged to command in deep stretch and held sway under a drive. GOOD GAME stalked a duel while three wide, moved to a short lead mid way on the final turn and battled gamely inside the winner. KOBOLD was taken to rate, advanced three wide between rivals around the far turn, continued willingly but was no match for the top two. HAWK AFFAIR lacked speed, swung wide for the drive and failed to respond. BLUSHING BROAD failed to menace. STATELINESS stalked the early pace, raced four wide between horses around the far turn and tired. HOLY BELLE dueled through quick fractions while two wide and tired in upper stretch. DINNER PARTY angled to the rail soon after the start, saved ground most of the way and tired. STORMY MATTERS rushed to contention, dueled through brisk fractions along the inside and stopped after six furlongs.
