FUNNY CIDE was brushed slightly by NEW YORK HERO at the start, moved up three wide approaching the first turn, stalked the pace while well in hand along the backstretch, launched a rally three wide leaving the far turn, closed the gap midway on the turn, accelerated to the front nearing the quarter pole, opened a commanding lead under right hand urging in midstretch, extended his advantage when struck with the left hand a sixteenth out then drew off under a vigorous hand ride. MIDWAY ROAD broke inward bumping with TEN CENTS A SHINE at the start, was unhurried along the rail through the opening half mile, made a sharp move inside the winner at the half mile pole, saved ground while racing just behind the leader leaving the turn, battled along the inside in midstretch, was brushed by PEACE RULES with a sixteenth remaining then unfinished SCRIMSHAW for the place. SCRIMSHAW moved up along the rail to gain a brief advantage in the early stages, relinquished the lead to PEACE RULES midway on the first turn, moved out along the backstretch, raced within striking distance while three wide on the turn, closed the gap in upper stretch, came in a bit under right hand urging to bump twice with PEACE RULES a sixteenth out then continued on willingly to gain a share. PEACE RULES battled for the early lead from outside, opened a clear advantage leaving the seven-eighths pole, was rated on the front while slightly off the rail along the backstretch, maintained a clear advantage to the turn, relinquished control to the winner approaching the quarter pole, remained a factor into midstretch, was bumped twice while in tight quarters between horses at the sixteenth pole then weakened from his early efforts. SENOR SWINGER trailed for a good portion of the trip, circled five wide entering the stretch then improved his position with a belated rally in the middle of the track. NEW YORK HERO broke outward brushing slightly with the winner at the start, raced in the middle of the pack while five wide for a half, angled to the rail on the far turn, raced within striking distance to the top of the stretch then faded in the drive. FOUFA'S WARRIOR broke in the air a bit then was pinched back at the start, saved ground while well back for six furlongs, angled three wide leaving the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. CHEROKEE'S BOY up close while saving ground for five furlongs, angled out on the far turn, circled five wide into the stretch then lacked a further response. TEN CENTS A SHINE was brushed by MIDWAY ROAD at the start, checked and altered course to the outside

while rank approaching the first turn then never reached contention and was not abused while well back through the stretch. KISSIN SAINT bobbed at the start, raced three wide along the backstretch and lacked the needed response when called upon.
