DROP IT NOW sent up three wide into the first turn to attend the pace, dueled between rivals from the five sixteenths pole to mid stretch, switched to his correct lead a sixteenth out, battled back to the inside of RAMPAIGE and got back up in in the final yards. RAMPAIGE was rated off heels while inside into the clubhouse turn, altered out near the five eighths pole, moved three wide to join the fray leaving the far turn, dueled, gained command in mid stretch, continued in front to late then hung. ROLLTHEDICEAGAIN stalked the pace, angled five wide for the drive and rallied mildly. FLIPFLOPSANDSOCKS gained command soon after the start, dropped to the rail, dueled through slow fractions, held well to mid stretch and weakened. SWEEP FIRST, unhurried early while off the rail, angled six wide for the drive but lacked a bid. PARKER'S LOVE was steadied back from between rivals leaving the gate, saved ground and failed to respond. NATIONAL STANDARD was outrun.
