LAST GUNFIGHTER broke alertly and was kept within range of EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH while well removed from the inside, was put to a stiff drive leaving the far turn, took closer order nearing the lane, sustained his run under stout handling, reeled in EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH approaching the sixteenth marker then pulled away while being kept to task. EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH cleared under the wire the first time, set a slow pace well within himself, widened a bit leaving the far turn, came under a ride entering the stretch, was overtaken inside the furlong grounds, faded but remained well clear of the rest. RICHARD'S KID settled back off the early pace while towards the inside, angled wide leaving the five eighths pole but failed to generate any type of significant response. INDIAN DANCE lagged back, came wide for the drive and failed to menace. CONCEALED IDENTITY, off the rail, failed to make an impact. BRIMSTONE ISLAND, away alertly, tracked the pace racing towards the rail, was under pressure after five furlongs and gave way.
