Footnotes

HEART OF ROME stalked the pace, advanced in the three path on the turn, closed determinedly outside TALENT N PASSION and was along in time. TALENT N PASSION sped to a clear, early lead, set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. CURLAMOROUS lacked speed, was four deep on the turn, angled to the six path in midstretch and rallied. DIXILUNA lacked speed, circled foes, was fanned to the five path entering the stretch and lacked the needed late response. CALLMEWHACHUWANT bobbled leaving the starting gate, swung to the four path turning for home, advanced between horses and weakened late. MY TRUE LADY failed to rally. WHO NEEDS prompted the pace outside TALENT N PASSION and gave way in upper stretch. BIG ARDAN bobbled at the break, raced along the rail and steadily retreated. ORLYANA QUEEN stumbled leaving the starting gate, steadied leaving the backstretch, stopped and was eased late.
