I'M MOM'S FAVORITE, in close at the break, settled well off the early pace, gained momentum five wide into the stretch, rallied under strong left handed pressure to take over departing the sixteenth pole, was under steady hand urging from there and narrowly prevailed. FLATTERING BEA, in tight at the break, lagged well back through the opening half mile, shifted out six wide for the drive, closed with a rush and just missed. LIGHTHOUSE BAY, bumped and pinched back at the break, quickly gained four wide entering the lane, bid to engage TREAD in mid stretch, pressed to the sixteenth marker and faded. TREAD took over soon after the break, set the pace towards the rail, took pressure from BIG SKY COUNTRY three furlongs out, shook away from that one in upper stretch, was re-engaged a furlong out, battled past the sixteenth pole then gave way grudgingly. JEWEL OF A CAT was bumped soundly at the break, angled in soon after and gained a stalking spot, shifted out near the eighth pole but failed to muster up the needed kick. BIG SKY COUNTRY drifted out at the break and caused a jam up, was straightened away soon after, prompted the pace two wide, moved to challenge leaving the far turn, forced the issue into the stretch then tired. LIVIN PEACE leaned in at the break and bumped JEWEL OF A CAT, chased wide to the quarter pole and tired. CHEETAH PANTS saved ground and failed to menace.
