TWO ITEM LIMIT , jostled leaving the starting gate, raced in the three path entering the stretch, eased out wide in upper stretch, led in midstretch then drew out under rousing. INDY GLORY stalked the pace near the rail, was steadied waiting for room approaching the stretch, found room inside horses the final furlong and finished gamely. TAP DANCE , jostled leaving the starting gate, prompted the pace two wide, gained the lead entering the stretch and surrendered in the drive. VINES OF JUSTICE , three wide the first turn, raced four wide turning for home and weakened. SCOOP came out a bit leaving the starting gate, set the pace along the rail, faltered and was eased. .
