WAR EMBLEM prompted the pace outside of MENACING DENNIS under stout rating, raced four wide into the backstretch, took over nearing the three furlong marker, drew clear mid way on the final turn then was fully extended to hold off MAGIC WEISNER. MAGIC WEISNER saved ground while unhurried, angled out mid way on the final turn, swung outside of HARLAN'S HOLIDAY in upper stretch and closed gamely while racing on his left lead. PROUD CITIZEN lost ground while racing five wide for a good portion of the opening six furlongs, made a run outside of the winner to loom boldly in mid stretch but could not sustain his bid. HARLAN'S HOLIDAY lost ground four wide most of the trip, advanced into contention nearing the stretch but lacked a strong closing response. EASYFROMTHEGITGO settled in the two path in the early stages, angled out five wide approaching the stretch, altered course back to the inside in mid stretch and finished evenly. U S S TINOSA was hustled along inside trying to keep the early pace, steadied briefly behind the leaders entering the stretch then drifted out while fading in the final furlong. CRIMSON HERO broke a bit awkwardly, trailed for nearly a mile, raced wide in the drive and passed tiring rivals. MEDAGLIA D'ORO raced in close pursuit between rivals under some rating, continued within striking distance to the quarter pole then tired. STRAIGHT GIN lacked speed while saving ground, swung six wide for the drive, failed to respond then pulled up in apparent distress and was vanned off. MENACING DENNIS angled to the inside after sprinting clear in the opening furlong, set a pressured pace inside of the winner to the far turn

then gave way steadily thereafter. TABLE LIMIT steadied on the heels of rivals entering the first turn, raced very wide down the backstretch and tired. BOOKLET raced wide between rivals while just off the pace for six furlongs, faltered leaving the far turn and was not abused late. EQUALITY steadied briefly nearing the clubhouse turn, raced wide and failed to threaten.
