Footnotes

HELLO LOVER settled in the clear while not too far back, cruised up four wide through a seam entering the lane, responded when set down in upper stretch, kicked well clear a furlong out and was kept alert to the wire. NO BRAKES , unhurried early while towards the inside, worked outward advancing mid way on the final turn, came four wide for the drive, shifted in some past the eighth pole and willingly closed the gap. WHO DAT BOY was taken wide nearing the seven eighths pole when appearing difficult to settle, rushed up and went clear nearing the five eighths pole, was displaced from the inside leaving the far turn, got out six wide nearing the lane, was corrected past the three sixteenths marker but lacked the needed finish. RECKLESS RUNNER , with the pace, moved between horses leaving the five eighths pole then poked a head in front with a half mile remaining, took outside pressure around the turn and into the lane, lost command soon after, gave chase past the eighth pole then weakened slightly. ARCTIC RAVEN lagged back, came three wide for the drive and passed tiring rivals. ANZIO ADAM gained a good stalking position early, was put to a drive chasing around the final turn, remained a factor to upper stretch then faded. LOVE TALK cleared early while along the rail, lost the lead in early backstretch, re-bid inside rivals after a half mile, vied to the five sixteenths marker then tired. LEADHILLS stumbled badly leaving the gate then was pinched back soon after, had his rider adjust his right iron, raced three wide around the first turn, quickly gained between runners leaving the five eighths pole, gave pursuit to the quarter pole then retreated. TRAPPIST MONK , fractious in the gate, garnered a forward spot while saving ground around the clubhouse turn, shifted out under pressure into the far turn, failed to respond and faltered.
