SUMMER APPLAUSE patiently tracked a slow pace while three wide, moved to engage the leader nearing the turn, remained chilly prompting MOON PHILLY approaching the stretch, overtook that one passing the three sixteenths marker, responded when set down left handed inside the furlong pole, turned away an outside threat from SEA ISLAND with a sixteenth to go and edged away under steady handling. SEA ISLAND, four wide within striking distance, stalked a three pronged battle leaving the far turn, came under pressure after six furlongs, rolled up outside to loom a serious factor nearing the sixteenth pole, kept on willingly but was denied by the winner. BRUSHED BY A STAR, unhurried off the slow pace, swung out past the three sixteenths pole but could not muster up the needed rally. DAYDREAMIN GRACIE went clear early, set a slow pace towards the inside, was overtaken nearing the far turn, gave willing chase to upper stretch then faded. MOON PHILLY stumbled at the break, recovered soon after and stalked towards the inside, eased out and rushed up between rivals to take a short lead around the far turn, took outside pressure from the winner into the lane, was headed soon after, stayed gamely to mid stretch then gave way.
