Footnotes

REMARKABLE NEWS (VEN) stalked the pace off the rail, altered course to the outside to avoid MENDING FENCES entering the far turn, moved out to a clear lead under a light hold, drifted out some late and prevailed under a drive. COSMONAUT angled off the rail into the backstretch, stalked the pace three wide, jumped MENDING FENCES when that one broke down entering the far turn, chased the winner into the stretch, closed gamely and steadily gained. OUTPERFORMANCE , towards the inside early, steadied when avoiding MENDING FENCES nearing the far turn, advanced between rivals into the lane, eased out leaving the furlong marker and closed willingly. SILVER TREE steadied when in tight between rivals soon after the start, saved ground, steadied again while nearing the far turn, made steady progress along the rail in mid stretch then flattened out late. DREADNAUGHT , in tight soon after the break, saved ground, steadied nearing the far turn, eased out some late then lacked a solid finish. WOODLANDER , three wide between rivals, steadied entering the far turn, continued wide between foes into the stretch then lacked a stretch kick. CAN'T BEAT IT was bumped soon after the break, circled five to six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. STAY CLOSE (GB) , three wide early, jumped MENDING FENCES nearing the far turn, chased the pace around the final turn and faded. GENERAL JUMBO (GB) was shuffled back soon after the break and failed to menace. MENDING FENCES was sent clear early,

set a quick early pace towards the inside then broke down nearing the far turn. EINSTEIN (BRZ) , off the rail, lost his rider when attempting to avoid MENDING FENCES entering the far turn.
