Footnotes

IL VILLANO , away alertly, prompted the pace three wide under rating, forged to command when set down into the lane, quickly widened under right handed pressure in mid stretch, lugged in but held firm as the rider switched to the left stick. LAURIE'S ROCKET , bounced around and in close at the break, recovered to reached contention racing four wide into the turn, continued four wide chasing the leaders into the stretch then had enough to edge INNOCENT MAN for the place. INNOCENT MAN stumbled at the break then drifted out into LAURIE'S ROCKET soon after, was corrected and pulled his way clear while two wide, took pressure from the winner nearing the turn, was overtaken entering the stretch, gave way grudgingly the final furlong and just lost the place. TRIPPI'S SECRET rated behind rivals into the turn, angled out for the drive but lacked a late response. SCARAMAGNA broke a step slow, was hustled up soon after and gained a tracking spot along the rail, came under pressure around the turn, failed to kick in and faded. HE CAN RUN drifted in slightly at the break bumping with LAURIE'S ROCKET, was bumped again and pinched back soon after, dropped well off the early pace, saved ground into the lane but could not overcome the rough start. MANDORLA , bumped leaving the gate, chased between rivals into the turn then tired after three furlongs. There was a stewards' inquiry into the start and an objection by the rider of LAURIE'S ROCKET against the winner for alleged interference leaving the gate. Following a review, the stewards found no reason for action.
