**Footnotes**

CLARE SKIES AHEAD , steadied in tight quarters entering the far turn, worked between horses entering the stretch, angled to the seven path approaching the eighth pole, closed strongly and drove clear. HAPPY CHOICE , unhurried, floated five wide entering the stretch and gained the place at the wire. DIXIE DEAR saved ground the first turn, eased out on the backstretch while stalking the pace, moved up in the three path on the far turn and flattened out between horses. NEKIA'S VOW set the pace along the rail, opened up in midstretch and gave way late. MAGICAL MERRY , in the three path turning for home, failed to rally in an even effort. OUR GIN MILL hugged the rail through the stretch and lacked room behind NECKIA'S VOW near the sixteenth pole. HIDDEN JOY prompted the pace two wide and gave way in midstretch. LUCKY HOLLY , very wide the far turn, was not a factor. FAVORED LADY , along the rail turning for home, was outrun. DISTORTED DISCIPLE lost ground on the turns and gave way. PRINCESS SUCREE trailed.
