Footnotes

RED BULLET, unhurried early, was in hand while taking an awkward step approaching the first turn, settled well off the pace for a half, gradually worked his way forward between horses leaving the backstretch, waited patiently for room midway on the turn, split horses while making his move inside FUSAICHI PEGASUS nearing the quarter pole, charged to the front in upper stretch, opened a clear advantage in midstretch then drew away under steady left handed encouragement. FUSAICHI PEGASUS, pinched back a bit at the start, was kept to the outside while going five wide into the first turn, raced in the middle of the pack while well off the rail along the backstretch, continued five wide while making a mild move when asked for run midway on the turn, drifted in a bit nearing the three-sixteenths pole then weakened a bit while holding for the place. IMPEACHMENT raced well back after breaking slowly, trailed while far back for five furlongs, rapidly closed the gap along the inside midway on the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch then rallied mildly to gain a share. CAPTAIN STEVE moved to the inside soon after the start, was unhurried for five furlongs while slightly off the rail, angled to the outside on the turn, launched a bid six wide leaving the quarter pole then failed to threaten while closing some ground in the middle of the track. SNUCK IN steadied behind the leaders in the early stages, was under a snug hold while just off the rail along the backstretch, raced within striking distance along the inside to the top of the stretch, then gradually tired thereafter. HUGH HEFNER took the lead along the inside going into the first turn, alternated for command slightly off the rail along the backstretch, battled heads apart into upper stretch then weakened from his early efforts. HIGH YIELD moved up between horses to contest the early pace, gained a slim advantage midway down the backstretch, fought heads apart outside HUGH HEFNER to the top of the stretch then gave way readily in the stretch. HAL'S HOPE broke inward a bit at the start, prompted the pace while four wide for seven furlongs, steadied in tight nearing the quarter pole then faltered and was not abused in the late stages.
