BROKEN VOW was a bit difficult to load, prompted the pace four wide under rating, was urged along on the final turn, drew clear in upper stretch and prevailed under stiff left handed pressure. GRUNDLEFOOT was unhurried early while off the rail, circled five wide around the final turn and closed gamely. INNER HARBOUR moved closer under rating in the two path near the half mile pole, angled out four wide approaching the lane, rallied but could not go with the top pair late. VALIANT HALORY prompted the pace three wide, lodged a bid mid way on the final turn, remained a presence to mid stretch and faded. SUN CAT pressed the pace two wide between rivals and tired nearing mid stretch. PICKUPSPEED broke slowly and was outrun. TIM'S CROSSING gained command entering the first turn, set a pressured pace along the rail and faltered in upper stretch. TRUE CONFIDENCE saved ground and was finished after six furlongs.
