DR. MAX was unhurried early, raced wide around the turn, swung wider in upper stretch, closed determinedly and was up at the wire. MOON OVER PROSPECT raced in the two path between horses around the turn, opened a clear lead in midstretch, drifted out in the drive and just missed. CRUCIBLE raced wide around the turn and flattened out between the top pair. MEMORY TAP raced in the two path around the turn and failed to menace. GRAND HOPE raced in hand leaving the backstretch, saved ground and was never a factor. LOADED GUN sped to the front, had speed along the rail and gave way. YES IT'S TRUE bobbled slightly at the break, had speed three wide between horses, gave way into the stretch, drifted out and stopped.
