MYTHICAL HERO , pinched back leaving the starting gate, rushed up wide entering the far turn, continued wide, closed steadily and drove clear. STEADY EDDIE bore out leaving the starting gate, set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. AZTEC RUN bore in leaving the starting gate, prompted the pace two wide, bid for the lead leaving the far turn and weakened between the top pair. ROYAL THEATRE , fractious in the post parade, bore out leaving the starting gate, raced wide on both turns and finished willingly. GO FOR PORTER , unhurried early, failed to rally. NAVY BRASS saved ground, stalked the pace and came up empty in the drive. POLLARDS IMAGE , checked in tight quarters entering the first turn, failed to be a factor and raced wide entering the stretch. FARNDALE , pinched back leaving the starting gate, bore out entering the first turn and weakened. CELEBRATORY , wide the first turn, was checked in traffic near the half mile pole and faltered.
