Footnotes

BUD DRAFT PLEASE was sent up outside and disputed the pace into the turn, rated back off of CAVALLO GRIGIO on the turn, surged three wide to command in upper stretch, kicked clear in mid stretch and proved best under a drive. CAVALLO GRIGIO , hustled from the gate, set the pace along the inside, was overtaken in upper stretch, weakened a bit late but managed to save the place. CRYSTAL BEACH , four wide on the turn, ranged up five wide into the lane and closed willingly. ATRIA failed to keep pace early, angled out in deep stretch and finished with good energy. JUST NOT ENOUGH , wide early, angled to the rail mid turn, chased the pace into the lane and came up empty. BOUNCE , wide, failed to menace. CHARMED AGAIN , rank early chasing the pace, raced between horses into the stretch, angled in near the furlong marker and faded. TOKENNESS failed to menace. IGLOO ANNIE was not a factor. WYE VALLEY saved ground leaving the three furlong marker and failed to respond. UNBRIDLED ARIA lacked speed, saved ground into the stretch and failed to menace. BUSH LANDSLIDE broke slowly, ducked in soon after and was outrun.
