Footnotes

HESAGOLDMINE saved ground stalking the pace, advanced along the rail to take command midway on the far turn, turned back a challenger in midstretch and edged clear. GLOBAL GENIUS (IRE) , rated back from between horses passing the finish line the first turn, raced in the two path through the stretch and rallied. RANDOM STRIKE stalked the pace, advanced outside the winner on the far turn, bid for the lead approaching the eighth pole then weakened. GIANT TALENT saved ground stalking the pace, eased out wide in upper stretch and came up empty in the drive. CAPE GIRARDEAU , wide turning for home, passed tired horses. GHOST STAG saved ground and was not a factor. FINGER TAPPING lost ground on the turns and was outrun. PAPA IM hugged the rail and was never a factor. QUEENS PARTNER , rank when rated back early, raced wide entering the stretch and faltered. ZAPATISTA stopped and was eased. BAT OUTTA HEAVEN set the pace, bore out badly leaving the far turn and was eased.
