CHINGLISH saved ground under patient handling, eased out to the three path in upper stretch, bid for the lead between horses inside the eighth pole then rapidly drew off in the drive while under brisk urging. HUMBLE AND HUNGRY, rated back entering the first turn, stalked the pace outside JOES BLAZING AARON, overtook that one in upper stretch, finished gamely but was no match for the winner. MASTER DUNKER lacked speed, saved ground around the far turn, swung out in upper stretch and rallied late to gain the show position. LIL BIT O'FUN, unhurried to the far turn, advanced nicely three wide approaching the stretch, floated wide in upper stretch, had aim on the lead in midstretch, switched to his left lead near the eighth pole then faltered. JOES BLAZING AARON sprinted to a clear lead entering the first turn, saved ground setting the pace, remained prominent to midstretch then gave way. DISTORTED APPEAL, not an early factor, raced in the three path turning for home then failed to rally. STORMY THE CAT, in the two path entering the stretch, was outrun. BALTO MORE, three wide the first turn, chased the pace, drifted wide entering the stretch then gave way. BROAD RULE saved ground on the far turn and gave way in upper stretch.
