VENTANA moved up between rivals soon after the break to dispute the pace, assumed command in hand three furlongs out, responded when put to stout right handed urging in upper stretch, dueled inside IMMORTAL EYES from the three sixteenths marker, drifted out from left handed urging leaving the sixteenth pole and brushed with that rival, was straightened away soon after, had his rider drop his whip in deep stretch but dug in tenaciously to hold sway. IMMORTAL EYES broke sharply then rated back off the dueling leaders, moved four wide to challenge entering the stretch, dueled outside the winner, was brushed leaving the sixteenth marker and battled gamely to just miss. CHINA chased the pace four to five wide and continued on willingly to gain the show. NATHAN'S H Q , bumped and pinched back at the break, was hustled up off the rail nearing the turn, chased the leaders around the turn, angled out three to four wide entering the stretch then came up empty. HERITAGE HALL , bumped at the break, lagged far back, raced wide in the drive and offered some belated action. DELONG ROAD bobbled inward at the break and bumped with NATHAN'S H Q , rushed up inside rivals to take a short lead leaving the five eighths pole, dueled inside the winner to the head of the lane then weakened in mid stretch. SAFETY CHECK , four wide, made a mild run between rivals nearing the lane then faded in the final furlong. MY CUZ C J , bumped at the break, saved ground and lacked a response. GATTOPARDO , urged along while well removed from the rail, failed to keep pace and faded. There was a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run and an objection by the rider of IMMORTAL EYES against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch but no action was taken
