LOST JUDGEMENT sprinted to the front, set the pace near the rail and prevailed under steady handling. ROULETTE worked between horses on the turn and rallied belatedly. FRISKY ENCOUNTER, very wide entering the stretch, needed more. PERFECT CHALLENGE saved ground and lacked a rally. DODONA raced along the rail leaving the backstretch, drifted wide leaving the turn and weakened. TIMELY IRONY, wide, weakened. SUBTLE SONG was outrun. HILARY EDEN, wide leaving the backstretch, gave way and was eased late.
