Footnotes

ENNIS saved ground around the turn, secured command in upper stretch, drifted out in midstretch and prevailed under brisk urging. ONE SUNDAY , in a pocket entering the turn, worked between horses in upper stretch, angled to the six path in midstretch and closed late. WILD MAN WALKIN disputed the pace in the two path, drifted wide entering the stretch and weakened in the drive. PRINCE NOIR , three wide entering the stretch, failed to sustain his bid inside horses. RUBIDIUM circled the turn, dueled, was fanned very wide entering the stretch and weakened late. NO MORE TEARS , steadied when getting out leaving the starting gate, saved ground on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. BILLIONAIRE BOB , wide around the turn, was not a factor. PEACE TALKER hugged the rail, bobbled entering the turn and trailed thereafter.
