ALEXANDRA VICTORIA hopped at the break then checked when in tight, raced well back early, saved ground while advancing nearing the lane, angled out, closed between rivals nearing the sixteenth pole, surged to command and drew clear under a drive. SOMETHING SUAVE stalked the dueling leaders, lodged a three wide bid mid turn, drifted out some on a short lead entering the lane, dueled past the furlong marker, faded late and lasted for the place. EHLAMLOVESTODANCE lost ground four to five wide chasing the pace and continued on willingly to the wire. IRON DIVA , outrun early, raced seven wide in the drive and closed belatedly. ZIP CITY DANCER , away alertly, set a pressured early pace, dueled from mid turn to mid stretch then weakened. PERFECT HALO disputed the pace between rivals around the turn then weakened leaving mid stretch. NEARLY FAMOUS , bumped at the break, saved ground stalking the early pace, swung out wide for the drive and gave way. POLISH GAL broke outward and bumped NEARLY FAMOUS, failed to keep pace and gave way.
