MAKE MY SATURDAY cleared early, was joined from the outside by two rivals approaching the half mile marker, lost command around the far turn, was nicely rated from there, regained command when called upon approaching the stretch, shook clear after being roused right handed in upper stretch then steadily pulled away while kept to task. SHOW SOME LOVIN moved between foes to poke a head in front after a quarter mile, dueled mid turn, lost the lead into the lane, switched to his left lead inside the furlong marker, weakened from there but did salvage the place. ASCENDANCY broke a step slow, recovered and advanced three wide moving towards the turn, chased the leaders but lacked a serious stretch response. LE TRICHEUR bore out into PUNCHES R FLYING leaving the gate, drafted back in hand, raced three wide under rating mid turn, altered in off heels in upper stretch then found decent energy in the final fifty yards. AWESOME LION hopped at the break, regrouped and showed a nice burst to join the fray approaching the turn, vied outside foes past mid turn then faltered in upper stretch. PUNCHES R FLYING, bumped at the break, chased towards the inside and weakened. HELLO ABRAXON, in close at the break, lagged well off the pace, was under a ride nearing the quarter pole, swung six wide and had some belated action. POETRY IN NOTION, between runners early giving pursuit, dropped back.
