Footnotes

INISH SHANK saved ground stalking the pace, slipped through inside BLOWN AUDIT in upper stretch and drew off under vigorous rousing. EVANGELISM stalked the pace, raced wide and flattened out. BLOWN AUDIT sped to the front, set the pace along the rail, drifted out entering the stretch and weakened. LAURRUPIN'S MAN stalked the pace, raced in the two path through the stretch and came up empty. AMBER DADDY raced in the six path through the stretch and was no late threat. UP HILL SURVIVOR was no factor. CRAVE THE WAVE , steadied leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail and passed tired ones. CHANGEABLE BREEZE , outrun, raced in the seven path entering the stretch. BAREHEADED , outrun, raced six wide entering the stretch. CHASIN' CHARLIE , three wide turning for home, faltered. FLYING SCAMPY , in tight quarters near the three eighths pole, fell back and was eased.
