Footnotes

APRIL'S DIXIE BELL circled the turn while stalking the pace, eased out wide in upper stretch, closed nicely outside foes and drew off under urging. FRISBEE disputed the pace outside HARBOR FOX, drifted out in midstretch and weakened. SYDNEY SPEAKS stalked the pace two wide, swung out in upper stretch, drifted in near the eighth pole and flattened out between horses. QUEEN OF THE DISCO , two wide around the turn, angled very wide in midstretch and closed late outside rivals. HARBOR FOX saved ground, disputed the pace and weakened. CHERRY WILDCAT , three wide on the turn, was not a factor. STAR RECRUIT , wide on the turn, was outrun. POBRECITA hugged the rail and was outrun.
