Footnotes

POPPY'S PUNKIN , patiently rated three wide in range, eased out wider past mid turn, responded when set down in upper stretch, forged to command under solid left handed pressure inside the eighth pole then eagerly edged clear late. SPELLIT prompted the pace while saving ground and under nice rating, slipped through along the rail to challenge in mid stretch, battled inside the winner to the sixteenth pole and kept on gamely while second best. BRI'S VISION , taken to rate four wide, edged closer near the quarter pole but could only muster a mild late response. PETER'S CREEK , bumped around and in tight at the break, rated along three wide to the head of the stretch then found his best too late between runners. SANDBAGIN' LOVER drifted in at the break bumping HALLUCINOJENIC, raced four to five wide and had a belated response. ONE BIG PLAY was nudged clear early, set a rated pace off the rail, was joined from both sides in mid stretch, gave brief resistance then faded. HEY DOC HOLIDAY stalked the pace three wide and weakened in the final furlong. HALLUCINOJENIC was bumped at the break, saved ground, made a slight move mid turn, failed to sustain and tired through the drive. OCHO CABALLOS was jostled and pinched back at the break.
