SAINTLY LOVE saved ground to the far turn, eased out midway on the bend, swung to the four path turning for home, swept to command under brisk urging and eagerly drew off. BARNARDS GALAXY saved ground, found room along the rail through the stretch and rallied gamely. CHILKOOT TRAIL saved ground to the stretch, swung to the five path in midstretch and rallied between horses. SHOOTDEWORX set the pace in the two path and weakened late. PICK FOUR , two wide the far turn, swung to the five path in upper stretch and failed to rally. KIPPERS N' EGGS , three wide the first turn, was four deep the far turn and gave way. COURT BAND , wide the far turn, was outrun. SARBANES was outrun. ONE SUNDAY chased the pace three wide and faltered in midstretch.
