Footnotes

WILD PAL , steadied in traffic midway on the first turn, circled the far turn, sprinted clear in midstretch and was kept to pressure. HIGHLAND BOWL , unhurried early, swung wide in upper stretch, drifted in near the eighth pole and rallied. NIGHTSCAPE disputed the pace two wide and weakened. FOXS SON OF GRACE lacked speed, raced off the rail in the stretch and finished willingly after being lightly steadied behind HIGHLAND BOWL in midstretch. COOL HAND JEFF , no factor, raced wide on the far turn. TRAFALGAR had speed along the rail and gave way. PATH OF PERFECTION , three wide on the turns, faltered. An objection by the rider of FOXS SON OF GRACE against HIGHLAND BOWL for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed.
