CASE OF THE BLUES was taken back to last after the start, advanced four wide in hand around the final turn, moved to a clear advantage in midstretch and held sway under constant pressure. INSIDE AFFAIR saved ground in a forward position, lodged a rail bid midway around the final turn, took a short lead in upper stretch then gave way grudgingly while drifting out. APRIL IN CALGARY broke a step slow, move to contention into the first turn, awaited room behind rivals around the far turn, angled to the inside leaving the three furlong marker, angled out late and steadied lightly late on the heels of INSIDE AFFAIR. CALL HOME EILEEN went clear early, set the pace off the rail, was collared after six furlongs, drifted out through the drive and weakened. INN BETWEEN lost ground four wide, moved to a striking position into the far turn, chased the leaders to the quarter pole then tired. TOOKIN DOWN stalked the pace three wide to the far turn and faltered.
