UNDERNEATH IT ALL raced along the rail down the backstretch, eased out midway on the far turn, was fanned wide entering the stretch, opened up in midstretch and prevailed under brisk urging. SKOOR lacked speed and rallied in the two path while racing on her left lead. WAYNE WO WEEMS , fanned five wide entering the stretch, weakened. POPULAR BLUES had speed along the rail and tired. O'BLANEY was no factor. AMBER JULE gained a two wide lead on the far turn, stopped and was eased.
