COUNSELLORS LADY prompted the pace two wide, was put to urging leaving the three furlong marker, took command into the lane, kicked clear leaving the three sixteenths marker then was all out to hold off REGAL MIRACLE. REGAL MIRACLE, unhurried early, advanced four wide into the lane, closed steadily but just could not get the winner. COPA lacked speed off the rail and could not generate a solid response. COUNTY RECOUNT set a pressured pace along the inside and surrendered nearing mid stretch. THEATRICAL MARK saved ground, was forwardly placed for a half mile then steadily faded. OPENING ACCOUNT stalked the early pace three to four wide and tired. BLEED TOO RED was outrun.
