TOTALLY SELFISH sped to the front, set the pace well off the rail and was under brisk urging in the drive. BABY BOOK drifted wide entering the stretch and rallied mildly. ANGIANNA chased the winner and faded in the drive. NATTIE NU raced in the two path in the stretch in an even effort. TO THE CROWD , wide on the turn, was no factor. CELESTIAL SKY raced along the rail and was no factor. ACTXPRESSO was caught in tight quarters leaving the backstretch. DOHA bore out entering the turn and raced very wide into the stretch. LADY ROCKER was carried very wide by DOHA entering the turn.
