QUEUE was unhurried early, angled five wide nearing the quarter pole, closed sharply, gained command leaving the sixteenth pole and was best under a drive. BRAZEN BRIDE prompted the pace two wide between rivals, gained command in mid stretch and finished gamely. GINGER'S PROUD was well placed off of a disputed pace, angled four wide near the quarter pole, raced wider in the lane and offered a mild response. PRIZED STAMP disputed the pace three wide and weakened late. RUTLEDGE AFFAIR was unhurried early, raced wide the final turn, angled in and came up empty. KOBOLD disputed the pace along the rail and weakened late. NIGHTTIME DANCES was never a factor. FOOLISH GATOR saved ground and was in a bit tight nearing the far turn.
