FULL LIFE took command soon after the start, controlled the pace along the inside while under rating, widened hear advantage around the final turn and maintained a safe margin under very confident handling. BEE BONNET stalked the pace between rivals down the backstretch, angled to the rail into the far turn, was put to urging nearing the quarter pole, angled out and chased the winner home in willing fashion. NORTHERN GAMBLER was unhurried early while in range, entered the lane three wide then lacked a solid response. BRAVE TESTAMONY saved ground, angled four wide into the lane and came up empty. PRETTY VALAY prompted the pace two wide and dropped back after six furlongs.
