CRAFTY TOAST was patiently rated inside horses, eased out to the two path in upper stretch, closed determinedly and was along in time. PROUD RUN set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. MARIA'S TIARA stalked the pace outside PROUD RUN and weakened late. LUCKY DISCOVERY saved ground down the backstretch and into the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and came up empty. AMOURETTE raced wide around the far turn and failed to sustain her bid. PROUD OWNER was outrun and raced wide in the stretch. VAGUELY RICH was steadied near the wire the first time around, was steadied in close quarters entering the backstretch, saved ground and lacked a rally. JAZZ stalked the pace three wide and gave way. NORTHERN FLAIR trailed.
