I KNEW A GIRL stalked the pace, advanced three wide entering the stretch and pulled away under energetic urging. SWEET LORETTA , bumped leaving the starting gate, swung to the four path in upper stretch and gained the place. WIDE AWAKE raced wide entering the stretch and was no threat. BEST APPROACH saved ground most of the race and lacked the necessary late response. SUN APPEAL bore in leaving the starting gate, raced wide on the turn, was in the seven path in midstretch and failed to be a factor. WANA PLAY WITH ME had speed along the rail and faded. BRISK REPORT was no factor. WE WONDER WHY pressed the pace two wide and gave way. THRILL , very wide, gave way. TRACK BAR raced along the rail and was outrun.
