RUN R G RUN raced along the rail on the far turn, eased out in upper stretch, took command between horses in midstretch and proved best in a hard drive. STONE GROOVE circled the far turn, raced wide into the stretch and finished gamely. SUSAN ASTAIRE , in tight quarters along the rail soon after the start, swung outside in upper stretch and rallied. MORNING HIGH quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace two wide and weakened. PEPPY MIS , unhurried early, raced wide and had a mild, late rally. TIP THE SCALE , steadied in close quarters along the rail entering the first turn, remained inside horses and weakened. SAVANNAH PRINCESS chased the pace three wide and weakened. KRUIS'N KELSEY was no factor. MARY'S JOY was steadied lacking room along the rail entering the far turn. RAINDROPS N ROSES , rated back early, bore out entering the first turn, raced very wide on both turns and was no factor. PRESS DOLL raced off the rail and dropped back. DATZFAST , steadied in tight quarters along the rail entering the far turn, weakened and was eased.
