Footnotes

RUSSIAN MARKET set the pace along the rail, turned back a challenge from LET'S CANOODLE inside the eighth pole then drove clear. LET'S CANOODLE, unhurried early, moved up three wide on the far turn, bid for the lead inside the eighth pole, hung and held the place. START THAT SONG saved ground, was steadied in close quarters near the three eighths pole, lacked room along the rail in midstretch, altered course to the outside near the eighth pole and finished gamely. MEANS OF GRACE raced wide and rallied. FIND THE TAO had a mild rally inside horses. POLISH CHOICE raced well off the rail and was no factor. CRYPTIC PLUM, three wide on the backstretch, stalked the pace and gave way. RICO ENDS WELL dropped back. THE FIFTH ELEMENT prompted the pace outside the winner and stopped.
