### Footnotes

ARRANGEMENT saved ground down the backstretch while well within range, eased out for the drive, advanced between rivals leaving the eighth pole, closed steadily and was along in time. BREEZY BRI cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, edged away leaving the three furlong marker, remained well clear past the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly in the final fifty yards. SKOOR , unhurried early, raced very wide in the drive and closed willingly. UNDERNEATH IT ALL saved ground, eased out some in the lane and finished willingly. ALISON KATE prompted the pace two wide, raced between rivals in mid stretch then weakened very late. JOVIAL LADY , a bit rank at the break, advanced five wide in upper stretch then weakened late. CLASSIC WHITE WINE , in a bit tight at the break, raced well back for six furlongs, swung out past the eighth pole and finished willingly. BY ROYAL DESIGN stalked the pace towards the inside and faded. WEEPECKET lost ground four wide stalking the pace, faltered after six furlongs and was not abused late.
