NASKRA'S STAR LILY was no factor. LAST QUEEN raced along the rail and was no factor. DIFFICULT was no factor under mild urging in the stretch. PRIVATE PROM PARTY gave way. DECEPTIVE was outrun. TIPPING LIGHTLY raced along the rail and dropped back. .
