NO HALOS HERE disputed the pace outside SHUGA'S REAL RUSH and drew off in midstretch. RICO ENDS WELL saved ground, eased out entering the stretch and rallied. BONUS BID lacked speed and rallied inside horses. POLISH CHOICE , swung wide in midstretch, rallied mildly. HIGH SIX FIGURES bore out leaving the starting gate and stumbled when appearing to clip heels near the quarter pole. SUMMER SHENANIGANS , three wide on the turn, gave way. BENRAY'S FLASH was outrun. SHUGA'S REAL RUSH had speed along the rail and faltered. MINNIEPRIZE stopped and was eased.
